CAMP

Wade, his father Ken, and brother Shane have guided and managed bear and moose camps in the far north for several years. Camps have averaged 19" bears season after season.

Due to our hunting style and resource management practices, we operate our bear camp as a totally portable tent camp that is flown into a new location every year – thus being able to ensure a trophy harvest every year.

Now, don't be fooled by the phrase tent camp. Rest assured, you will have a top quality sleep every night on our large outfitter cots that are equipped with large comfortable sleeping bags. Every outfitter tent is equipped with a wood stove in case of cool or wet weather in which case both you and your equipment will stay dry and warm.

Now, you might not believe this until you experience it but the cooking you will be served is quite possibly as good as what Grandma would make! You will wake up every morning to breakfast that includes freshly baked bread. You will even experience a full turkey meal during your stay.

Also, when you awake in the morning or before you decide to turn in for the night, you can enjoy a nice warm shower without bugs or pests so you can feel refreshed every day.

Due to our extreme remote locations, our camp is also equipped with a satellite phone in case of emergency. It is also available for your use at an additional fee. We also have a generator in camp for power so you will always be able to keep your cameras and batteries fully charged.

BLACK BEAR HUNT

There are a few different practices that our camp used to ensure a top quality harvest year in and year out. First of all, the average 21" bear in Northern Saskatchewan is 20 – 25 years old and possibly older. So, to ensure a harvest of these trophy bears, we insist on our camp operating in a new location every year. Every year that you hunt the same area, even though the number of bears in the area will provide a successful hunt, the average size will continue to drop.

Our baiting methods are the second reason we can ensure a top quality hunt. We run six hunters a week for four weeks and want at least three baits per hunter. These sites get baited daily and the bits accessed so that we can put our clients on to a trophy bear. We cover enough virgin territory that the 24th hunter in camp has equal opportunity as the first hunter to kill the largest bear.

Although it's not the main reason for coming to Northern Saskatchewan, you will also have an opportunity to experience fishing for Northern Pike and Walleye and possibly, depending on the camp's location, other species of fish. You will need a Saskatchewan fishing license if you choose to enjoy this experience.

For your convenience, we have completed a list of things that you should plan to bring for your Bear hunting experience with True North Adventures Ltd.

- Thermo Cell & extra refills
 - Clothing/Camouflage
 - Waterproof Boots (rubber or otherwise)
 - Hunting Gear – Depending on your hunt (Bows, arrows, guns, shells, etc.)
 - Preferred Snacks and beverages (liquor and/or cigarettes if you choose, as there is no store on site)
 - Pike Fishing Lures & 30 lb. test leaders
 - Sunscreen & Bug Spray (Johnson's "Bug Off" in an orange can is so far the tried & true best brand!)
 - Rain Suit
 - Camera
 - Towels/Facecloths
 - Bug Suit
 - Polarized Sunglasses
 - Personal Items & Toiletries
- (1) Flat Queen size (60") bed sheet that can be folded in half to be used as your sleeping bag liner.
 - Firearm Declaration forms filled out in triplicate, but not signed (if bringing a firearm).
 - Airline allows 75 lbs. of luggage (2 pcs. total) (\$0.70/lb. overweight) and prefers you pack in a soft-sided duffle bag as opposed to hard luggage
